CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgment that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. PCAV rules may be found at [www.ponyclubvic.org.au]
- All competitors entering the Open Competition - **including Pony Club Members** - MUST sign a **Public Liability Declaration** Form.
- Riders without adequate Insurance Liability Cover MUST ALSO complete the **Day Participant Waiver** and pay \$10 per day fee. Participants who are NOT current members of PCAV, Equestrian Australia* (EA), an Inter State Pony Club, Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHS), Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA) and cannot provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.00 cover must pay \$10 participation fee.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee. There will be no refunds after the closing date unless the event secretary for the event has been notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is supplied to the event secretary within 7 days of notification of scratching.
- Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively subject to ballot of entries. Preferences will be based on listed order on entry form.
- PCAV club member card, or verification form, must be presented at the event office before riding. Information must be accurate and rider onus applies subject to elimination, which will be enforced without exception.
- Gear check is required before each phase and competitors must be present at least 15 minutes before each phase begins. Medical armbands to be inspected at gear check and are to be worn in all phases.
- PCAV Gear Rules as at January 2017
- apply. Please ensure you comply, as non-compliance may result in elimination.
- Competitor numbers-the organizing committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country. Body numbers will be available at the event.
- Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCAV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
- All riders must be prepared to ride before the allocated time.
- Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Neither the organizing committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility what so ever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- Lunging is only permitted in the designated area by rider only.
- Riders or spectators may be photographed or filmed by official photographers or local press. These images may be used in newsletters, flyers, websites or other promotional

activities for the Central Zone of Pony Clubs or PCAV.
